

**Enforcement Schedule for Non-Compliance with HSA Rules and Regulations
§1703 Sanitary Sewer Compliance Post Hollidaysburg Sewer Authority Main Sewer Line
Replacement Projects**

The following schedule was developed in accordance with the Rules of Enforcement contained in §1703 of the Hollidaysburg Sewer Authority (HSA) Rules and Regulations (hereinafter referred to as Regulations):

1. Penalties will be assessed for any property that is not in compliance with the Regulations by the compliance date established by the HSA. A Notice of Violation will be issued for any property that fails to meet compliance with the Regulations.
2. For days one through thirty of non-compliance, a fine of \$50.00 per day will be assessed for each day of non-compliance.
3. For days thirty-one through sixty of non-compliance, a fine of \$75.00 per day will be assessed for each day of non-compliance.
4. For days sixty-one through ninety of non-compliance, a fine of \$100.00 per day will be assessed for each day of non-compliance.
5. For days ninety-one through one-hundred-twenty, a fine of \$175.00 per day will be assessed for each day of non-compliance.
6. For each day after day one-hundred-twenty, the maximum penalty of \$300.00 per day will be assessed for each day of non-compliance.
7. The HSA may, at its sole discretion, extend the compliance date.
8. If a property owner in violation of the Regulations submits to the HSA a bona fide contract signed by both the property owner and the contractor that contains (i) a scope of work that will bring the property into compliance with the Regulations and (ii) a date for completion of the work set forth in the contract (a completion date must be set forth in such bona fide contract in addition to having the appropriate scope of work and signatures of the property owner and contractor) that does not exceed 120 days from the compliance date established by the HSA and so long as the work is actually completed and the property achieves compliance with the Regulations by the same foregoing date, the HSA will hold the penalties in abeyance during the interim time period. During the time period from the delivery of the bona fide contract to the HSA until the property is brought into compliance with the Regulations, penalties will continue to accrue from the compliance date until the property owner attains compliance with the Regulations. If the property owner attains compliance no later than the completion date set forth in the bona fide contract, the penalties being held in abeyance will be eliminated.

9. The HSA, at its sole discretion, may terminate the abeyance of penalties for any property owner who fails to fulfil the obligations of the bona fide contract and fails to attain compliance with the Regulations. Upon termination of the abeyance of penalties, penalties will be assessed from the compliance date until the date that compliance with the Regulations is actually achieved.
