

ORDINANCE NO. 880

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HOLLIDAYSBURG
AMENDING CHAPTER 27 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
BY MOVING THE USE OF RECREATIONAL FACILITY, PUBLIC OR NONPROFIT,
FROM PERMITTED USE TO A USE BY SPECIAL EXCEPTION IN R-1, R-2 AND R-3
DISTRICTS**

SECTION ONE: TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Hollidaysburg Borough Zoning Ordinance Amendment No. 24."

SECTION TWO: PURPOSE

The Borough Council of the Borough of Hollidaysburg deems it appropriate in the furtherance of the purposes of the "Hollidaysburg Borough Zoning Ordinance" to amend said Ordinance by changing the use of Recreational Facility, public or nonprofit, from a permitted use in the R-1, R-2 or R-3 districts to a use by special exception.

SECTION THREE: AMENDMENT TO 207.2 AND 207.4

Section 207.2.C shall now read "Deleted by Ordinance No. 880"

Section 207.4 shall now have subpart E reading "Recreational Facility, public or nonprofit"

SECTION FOUR: AMENDMENT TO 208.2 AND 208.4

Section 208.2.E shall now read "Deleted by Ordinance No. 880"

Section 208.4 shall now have subpart E reading "Recreational Facility, public or nonprofit"

SECTION FIVE: AMENDMENT TO 209.2 AND 209.4

Section 209.2.E shall now read "Deleted by Ordinance No. 880"

Section 209.4 shall now have subpart E reading "Recreational Facility, public or nonprofit"


SECTION SIX: ENABLING ACT

SECTION SEVEN: EFFECTIVE DATE




