

ORDINANCE NO. 836
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF HOLLIDAYSBURG, ADOPTED ON THE 13TH DAY
OF APRIL, 1987, AS AMENDED

The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Hollidaysburg adopted on the 13th day of April, 1987, is hereby amended, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 201 (1) is hereby amended by the **addition** of the following streets:

§201. Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets.

1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applied, as a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

Holliday Hills Drive	Blossom Drive to Golden Lane	25 mph
Holliday Hills Drive	Jackson Farm Drive to Beaver Street	25 mph

Section 2. Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 209 (1) is hereby amended by the **addition** of the following street:

§209. Turning or Entering at Certain Intersections Prohibited or Restricted.

1. It shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle, of the type indicated, traveling upon the first-named street at any of the following intersections, in the direction or directions indicated in each case, to make a left turn and/or a right turn into the second-named street, as indicated, at any time when such a turn is prohibited by this Section:

Section 3. Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 412 (2) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§412. Reserved Parking Places for Handicapped May be Provided.

2. The following locations are hereby designated as spaces for handicapped parking, as defined in 412 (2):

Newry Street	West	229 feet north from Betts Street Intersection
Pine Street	South	512 Pine Street
Union Street	West	Meter Space 16
	West	Meter Space 18-A
	West	First space north from Walnut Street
	West	42 feet north from Blair Street
Wall Street	South	66 feet west from Jackson Street
Wayne Street	East	Meter Space 28

The driver of any such vehicle which parks in said space shall be relieved of any such liability for parking, other than the regular parking meter charges, for 60 minutes in excess of the legal parking period.

Section 4. Chapter 15, Part 5, Section 501 (1) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§501. Parking Meter Zones and Time Limits Established and Parking Meter Charges Authorized.

1. Parking meter zones are established upon and along certain streets in the Borough of Hollidaysburg, as shown on the Parking Meter Zone Map attached hereto as Exhibit A and dated September, 2007, and described as follows:

ZONE 1: Twelve Minute Parking Zone

Allegheny Street: Meter Spaces 2A, 2B, 3A, 8A and 85 B.

ZONE 2: Two Hour Parking Zone

Allegheny Street: From N. Juniata Street to Penn Street, both sides except for those spaces designated as a 12 Minute Parking Zone, as set forth in Zone 1, and the South side of Allegheny Street between Union Street and Penn Street.

Montgomery Street: East and West sides between Strawberry Alley and Cherry Alley.

ZONE 3. Four Hour Parking Zone

with the following:

§510. Ticketing of Vehicles Parked Unlawfully; Effect of Payment of \$5 Within 48 Hours.

2. The police officer or special officer making such report shall also attached to every such vehicle, a notice that such vehicle was parked in violation of this Part, which notice shall contact instructions to such owner or operator to report to the Borough Office of this Borough within ten (10) days of the time when such notice was attached and to pay at the Borough Office or courtesy box as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation, the sum of \$5 for the first hour or part of an hour the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part 5; the sum of \$10 for the second hour the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part; the sum of \$15 for the third hour or part of an hour the vehicle was parked in violation of this Part 5, said penalties shall be cumulative. Provided, however, if the violation is in a metered loading zone, the owner or operator shall pay the penalty as provided in Chapter 15, Part 4 §410. After the expiration of said ten (10) days, a notice of failure to pay and a demand for payment of the penalty as set forth above plus \$25 for a violation in a metered zone in violation of this Part 5 may be made in satisfaction of said violation, if paid within 48 hours from the date of the second notice. If payment is not made as hereinbefore set forth, any person violating the provisions of this Part 5 shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$25 plus the penalty set forth above, payable to the Borough of Hollidaysburg, and costs of prosecution; prosecution for each such violation shall be in accordance with the practice in the case of summary offenses, including default proceedings under Criminal Procedure Rule 65 or its equivalent. Each occurrence shall be considered a separate offense.

Section 6. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
