

**ORDINANCE NO. 826
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
BOROUGH OF HOLLIDAYSBURG, ADOPTED ON THE 13TH DAY
OF APRIL, 1987, AS AMENDED**

The Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Hollidaysburg adopted on the 13th day of April, 1987, is hereby amended, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 15, Part 2, Section 201 (1) is hereby amended by the addition of the following street:

§201. Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets.

1. Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified streets, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on any part of a street where a maximum speed limit applied, as a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that part of the street:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
Clark Street	Walnut & Hickory Streets	25 mph
Walnut Street	Jones & Bella Streets	25 mph

Section 2. Chapter 15, Part 4, Section 412 (2) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§412. Reserved Parking Places for Handicapped May be Provided.

2. The following locations are hereby designed as spaces for handicapped parking, as defined in 412 (1):

Clark Street	East	First two (2) spaces south from Strawberry Alley
	West	413 Clark Street (library)
Front Street	West	Meter Space 90
Montgomery Street	East	Meter Space 54
Mulberry Street	South	26 feet west from Montgomery Street (209 Montgomery Street)
Municipal Parking Lot	East	Meter Space 59
Newry Street	West	229 feet north from Betts Street Intersection
Pine Street	South	512 Pine Street

Union Street	West	Meter Space 16
	West	Meter Space 18-A
	West	First space north from Walnut Street
	West	42 feet north from Blair Street
Wall Street	South	66 feet west from Jackson Street
Wayne Street	East	Meter Space 28

The driver of any such vehicle which parks in said space shall be relieved of any such liability for parking, other than the regular parking meter charges, for 60 minutes in excess of the legal parking period.

Section 3. Chapter 15, Part 5, Section 501 (1) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

§501. Parking Meter Zones and Time Limits Established and Parking Meter Charges Authorized.

1. Parking meter zones are established upon and along certain streets in the Borough of Hollidaysburg, as shown on the Parking Meter Zone Map attached hereto as Exhibit A and dated September, 2007, and described as follows:

ZONE 1: Twelve Minute Parking Zone

Allegheny Street: Meter Spaces 2A, 2B, 3A, 8A and 85 B.

ZONE 2: Two Hour Parking Zone

Allegheny Street: From N. Juniata Street to Penn Street, both sides except for those spaces designated as a 12 Minute Parking Zone, as set forth in Zone 1, and the South side of Allegheny Street between Union Street and Penn Street.

Montgomery Street: East and West sides between Strawberry Alley and Cherry Alley.

ZONE 3. Four Hour Parking Zone

Front Street: East and West sides, between Strawberry Alley and Cherry Alley.

Wayne Street: East and West sides, between Strawberry Alley and Cherry Alley.

Union Street: East and West sides, between Strawberry Alley and Cherry Alley.

ZONE 4. Municipal Parking Lot - Eight Hour Parking Zone

Meter spaces 59 through 71.

Section 4. Effective Date:

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
